School-based / Work-Integrated Learning (WIL) / Practical Teaching:

Compulsory School-based learning or Work-Integrated learning must be completed in the Senior and FET phases during the period of study. This is also known as practical teaching and is based during the year in which the methodologies are enrolled for.

Duration of the School-based learning:

- Four (4) consecutive weeks in the first semester.
- Four (4) consecutive weeks in the second semester.
- The university reserves the right to place students in schools according to the training needs. Those who are permanently employed as teachers can complete their practical teachings at the schools where they teach, however, they may be placed at another school if they are not teaching in the phase they are enrolled for or not teaching the methodology enrolled for.

<i>Master of Education</i>	M_EDUC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a <i>BEd (Hons) degree</i>; or - an appropriate 480-credit NQF level 8 <i>professional bachelor's degree</i>; or - a relevant <i>honours degree</i> and an approved <i>professional teaching qualification</i>; or - a <i>postgraduate diploma</i> for a cognate Master of Education Degree programme, as long as it meets the HEQSF research requirement of at least 30 credits. - An average pass rate of 60% in the <i>honours module</i> relating to the MEd study, as well as a minimum of 60% for the <i>Research Methodology module</i>. - Admissions are only possible if a suitable supervisor is available for the proposed research topic.

Admission to an MEd Degree is subject to the approval of the relevant Head of Department or his/her delegate.

If a student did not obtain the necessary marks in the Research Methodology module, this module can be repeated prior to admission to the M Ed. Such a module will be registered as a module for non-degree purposes (NDP).

Except with the special permission of Senate, a candidate may not be registered for a master's degree for a period exceeding four years.
