


Student Portal Access


1. On the Desktop of the computer Click the **Internet Explorer** icon (you will then see the CUT website)




2. Click on the **Library** option on the top.



3. Scroll down till you see the **Archives: Exam Papers**



4. The following screen will appear.



5. Enter your username and password as follows:

Username= **CUT\Student Number**


E.g. CUT\2090000000

Password = ABCDE12\$

Note: **Do not check "Remember my credentials" checkbox**


6. Click **OK**




9. Click on the **Select Subject** field to select your specific subject.


