RETURNING TO CAMPUS

AT A GLANCE



The presence on both campuses will increase to 60%.



Staff and students who are required to return, will be informed.



The return will be structured and phased in over 4 weeks.



You still need a valid permit to access both of our campuses.



Visitors must have visitor's cards, and must follow all campus protocol.



During Level 2, 60% of the total staff and student population on both campuses will be invited back. Where possible, a rotational roster will apply for staff, to limit presence on campus.



Returning students will include those who are already on campus, those who require access to laboratories, and first-years in all programmes.

Returning staff will be determined by operational requirements. Working from home is encouraged, where possible, especially for people older than 60 years and those with underlying medical conditions.

Staff and students who may return to campus will be notified by their Line Managers and departments, respectively.

Returning to campus will be a structured and risk-controlled process that will be phased in over a period of 4 weeks. Priority will be given to first-year students, and the staff needed as per operational requirements.



All staff members and students who are allowed to access CUT campuses during lockdown Level 2, must be in possession of a Level 2 CUT Access Permit. This permit must be presented at access gates during the screening process.



Please limit visitors to a minimum, so that we do not exceed the 60% presence on our campuses at any time. All visitors need to undergo a screening process at the access gates, and must always have a CUT visitor's card with them.
