

Registration procedures for the 2022 academic year have been reviewed by the Office of the Registrar, in order to streamline various administrative processes. In an attempt to reduce the contact time and delays, the registration dates are scheduled for all faculties and qualifications for the duration of the registration period. The registration – including, but not limited to, subject changes, additions, terminations, and course changes – will commence online on 26 January 2022 and conclude on 08 February 2022.

**Note:** All Bachelor of Education students must have registered for both semesters during the first-semester registration period. However, those who are just coming for the first semester, still have to register for the 2022 academic year.

#### INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

For international students, there is a pre-registration process that takes place during registration, during which international students will be given required compliance forms to complete. In exchange, international students must submit the following documentation five days before registration to <a href="mailto:msejake@cut.ac.za">msejake@cut.ac.za</a> and <a href="mailto:kpakose@cut.ac.za">kpakose@cut.ac.za</a>.

- Certified copy of a valid passport.
- Certified copy valid study visa issued for the Central University of Technology, Free State
- Certified copy of an asylum/refugee status permit (
- Certified copy (proof) of medical cover with a medical scheme registered in South Africa in terms of the Medical Schemes Act (Act 131 of 1998). Cover must remain valid for the duration of the calendar year. CUT recommends the following medical aid, Momentum Health and Comp Care. ONLY medical aid recognised in South Africa will be accepted. NO hospital plans/insurance will be accepted.
- Proof of payment registration fee (R8600.00).

- Completed MIE form (see attached)
- Completed Compliance form (see attached)

NB: All compliance papers must be certified; CUT will not accept uncertified copies for registration.


