Kgomotso Lebelo holds a Master of Technology degree in Environmental Health from the University of Johannesburg, and is currently a lecturer in the Life Sciences Department at the Central University of Technology, Free State (CUT). In his PhD research, he explored chemical contamination in food, with specific reference to trace metal accumulation. The findings can improve food contamination surveillance and human health risk assessments in South Africa. His study establishes a platform for understanding the remediation needs of polluted agricultural land, and provides engagement by industry and academia to explore essential topics in food contamination and toxicological assessments. Two book chapters and two journal articles published in international journals were produced from his PhD, whilst two further articles are under review. He was the first-prize recipient of the 2020 Vice-Chancellor’s Excellence Award in Community Engagement. His research further impacts environmental health professionals through continuous development workshops targeting the environmental health profession and its sub-fields.

Mr Senbore is currently a postdoctoral research fellow in the Department of Geology at the University of Pretoria. He holds a master’s degree in applied geology from Kwara State University, and a bachelor’s degree in geology from Achievers University, Nigeria.

His doctoral research findings were notable in the areas of water and environmental sustainability in the Mangaung Metropolitan Municipality. He found that human activity and urban development had caused drought and water shortages in the greater Mangaung region. He developed an Urban Health Sustainability (UHS) model to assess and measure urban environmental and socio-environmental impact due to growing urbanisation in the Mangaung Metropolis. He also simulated future land use and land cover categories for urban expansion and water supply availability between 2028 and 2038. His study helps to comprehend the water and environmental impact resulting from a surge in urbanisation, and informs planning for the sustainable development of the Mangaung Metropolis.

Mr Matowane conducted a doctoral study titled, “Synthesis, characterisation and evaluation of the antidiabetic and antioxidative properties of caffeic acid and ferulic acid-zinc(II) complexes”. The study took advantage of the innate medicinal properties of zinc, caffeic acid and ferulic acid to synthesise two novel zinc complexes with improved antidiabetic and antioxidant potentials. The complexes may be relevant in concomitantly managing diabetes and oxidative stress. Mr Matowane produced three subsidy-bearing articles from his work, and co-authored six other articles during his doctoral studies. The data of the study was also presented at a reputable local conference.

Ms Ramorobi conducted a doctoral study titled, “Complexation of syringic and p-coumaric acids with zinc(II) to improve their antidiabetic efficacy”. In her study, she synthesised novel zinc complexes of p-coumaric acid and syringic acid. It was observed that zinc was a promising adjuvant for p-coumaric acid and syringic acid, which helped to improve their antidiabetic and antioxidant potential. The study suggests complexing zinc with these phenolic acids may be a promising therapeutic approach for concomitantly managing diabetes and associated oxidative complications. Ms Ramorobi produced three subsidy-bearing articles from her work, and co-authored four other articles during her doctoral studies. The data of her studies was also presented at a reputable international conference.
