T1.1 Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

The Central University of Technology, Free State invites tenders for framework agreement for professional project management services for the Central University of Technology, over a 3-year term without a guarantee of the quantum of work.

CUT will enter into an NEC3 Professional Services contract with the successful tenderer. Organs of state including other universities may make use of this Framework agreement and issue Task Orders for work falling within the scope of the contracts that are entered into.

The prequalification criteria in accordance with the Procurement Preferential Regulations 2017 are as follows:

• The tenderer is a B-BBEE status level 1 or 2 contributor.

Only tenderers who comply with these prequalification criteria are eligible to submit tender offers.

Only tenderers who comply with the requirements stated in the Tender Data are eligible to submit proposals.

Tenders are to be submitted online to the Online Tender Box that is located on the Tender Notice Page where procurement documentation are downloaded.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued.
