INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

For international students, there is a pre-registration process that takes place during registration, during which international students will be given required compliance forms to complete. In exchange, international students must submit the following documentation five days before registration to msejake@cut.ac.za.

- Certified copy of a valid passport.
- Certified copy valid study visa issued for the Central University of Technology, Free State
- Certified copy of an asylum/refugee status permit
- Certified copy (proof) of medical cover with a medical scheme registered in South Africa in terms of the Medical Schemes Act (Act 131 of 1998). Cover must remain valid for the duration of the calendar year. CUT recommends the following medical aid, Momentum Health and Comp Care. ONLY medical aid recognised in South Africa will be accepted.
- NO hospital plans/insurance will be accepted.
- Proof of payment registration fee (R8600.00) **returning students**
- Completed MIE form
- Completed Compliance form

NB: All compliance papers must be certified; CUT will not accept uncertified copies for registration.


RESIDENCE REGISTRATION PROCESS
